Next step in the task will be to input historical data for those club members who are not current but still have a connection with the club. The final step, if possible, will be to put historical 1st grade stats into the system. To this end, the club will need to enlist additional assistance from Adam. Unfortunately there are quite a lot of stats, such as from the lower grades, Veterans matches and Sunday League have been lost and as a result have been consigned to the annals of time.


